



Children Worship & Wonder (CWW)



CWW is a worship experience for children 4 years old - 4th grade that is Worship & Wonder offered during the 10:45 worship service. After the Children's Blessing they go to their own Worship and Wonder room. We greet one another, sing a song of praise and then hear and see one of the stories of God. The stories are told with simple pieces and gentle movement that truly draws the children into the story. After the story they are invited, through a series of questions, to wonder more about the story as they are invited to a time to work and wonder. Using various art items, Legos, books, or stories previously told, the children explore more. CWW is a wonderful gift to our children through which they really do learn the stories.

We need more storytellers! To be a storyteller you take a 3-4 hour training taught by Rev. Micki. In the training, you gain a deeper understanding of the set up and why's of CWW, how to tell the stories, and then experience a few stories so that you are confident of your roll as storyteller.

We'll offer a training in November. Please contact Rev. Micki if this a ministry you might be interested in. She'd be happy to talk to you more about it.
